REGULATIONS

Who Can Apply?

Any woman who is studying towards an LLB or LLB (Hons) degree at the University of Auckland.

Value: \$2,500 - payment will be made in a manner and on such conditions as the AWLA in its sole discretion thinks fit.

Decision Makers

The Auckland Women Lawyers Association - Margaret Wilson Scholarship 2008 ("Scholarship") is administered by the Auckland Women Lawyers Association Inc ("AWLA") through a selection committee ("Selection Committee"). The Selection Committee will consist of two members of the AWLA Executive, together with the President and Vice President of the AWLA.

Selection Criteria

In selecting the successful applicant, the Selection Committee will take into consideration (inter alia) scholastic ability, the nature of intended study and/or research, the potential of the applicant to make a significant legal contribution to the New Zealand community in the future, the applicant's interests in legal issues affecting women and the financial need of the applicant.

Suspension or Termination

The Selection Committee may at any time suspend or terminate the payment of the Scholarship if it determines (in its sole discretion) that the successful applicant is not diligently pursuing a programme of research or study or, the successful candidate has failed to comply with any of the terms and conditions on which the Scholarship was awarded.

Amendment to Regulations

The Selection Committee may, if it thinks fit, relax or modify the application of any of these regulations in any special circumstances or in order to avoid substantial hardship to any applicant.

- A covering letter of no more than two pages, addressing how the applicant believes that they meet the selection criteria, the applicant's proposed course of future study, intentions for future occupation and an explanation of how the Auckland Women Lawyers Association - Margaret Wilson Scholarship 2008 will assist the applicant.
- A copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae, including:
 - a) A certified copy of the applicant's academic record;
 - b) One written academic reference (with phone contact details supplied);
 - c) One written character reference from a responsible member of society (with phone contact details supplied);
 - d) A list of any scholarships and/or prizes the applicant has received to date; and
 - e) A list of any essays or articles published or books authored/co-authored by the applicant.
- The "Contact Details" page of this application form with the declaration signed and dated.
- The "Privacy Provisions" page of this application form which has been signed and dated.
